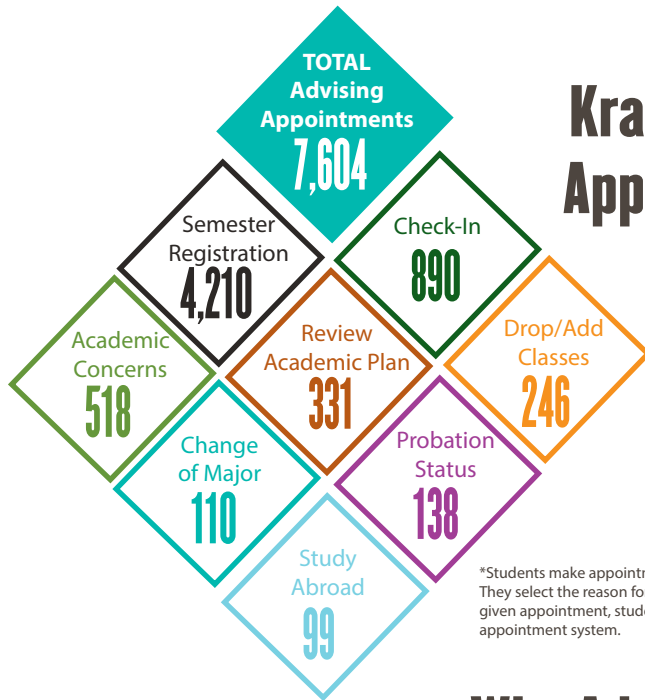


## Krannert Advisors

## Why Advising Matters

The Krannert Undergraduate Advising office **partners** with students to help guide them towards student success. Academic advisors also:

- » **Assist and coach** students in assessing their interests and abilities, examining their educational goals, making decisions and developing short-term and long-term plans to meet their objectives.
- » **Provide accurate and timely information** about degree requirements and institutional policies, procedures, and courses so students can select appropriate courses and other educational experiences.
- » **Evaluate and monitor student academic progress** and empower students to demonstrate self-direction and self-efficacy in the achievement of their educational goals.
- » **Make students aware of and refer** to educational and institutional resources and services (e.g., internship, study abroad, honors, service-learning, research opportunities, adaptive services, academic success center).

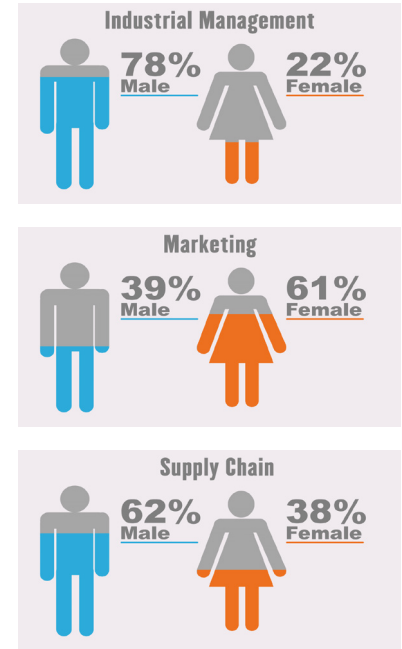
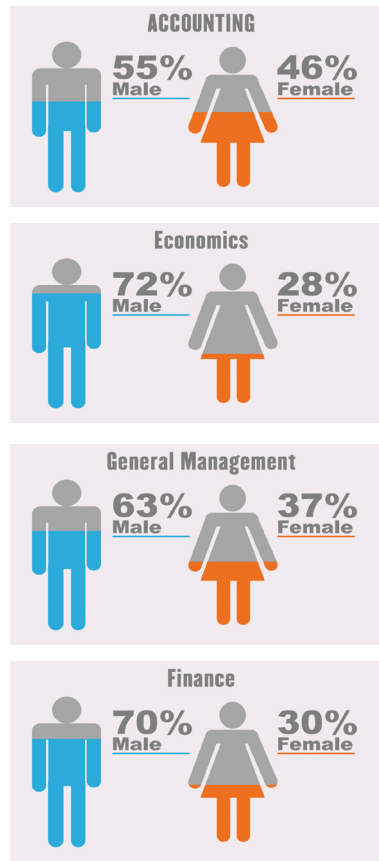
